Eugene Peterson, translator of “The Message” version of the Bible wrote a book in 1980 and wrote a 20th Anniversary revision of that same book in 2000. Somewhere around 2006 I read the book and went on to teach a Sunday School class on the same book. The book is titled, “A Long Obedience In The Same Direction: Discipleship in an Instant Society”.

This book focuses specifically on Psalms 120-134 which are known as the Songs of Ascents.

In the preface of the book the author writes, “I knew that following Jesus could never develop into a ‘long obedience’ without a deepening life of prayer and that the Psalms had always been the primary means by which Christians learned to pray everything they lived, and live everything they prayed over the long haul.”

He went on to say, “I wanted people to start *praying* them again, not just admiring them from a distance, and thereby learn to pray everything they experienced and felt and thought as they followed Jesus, not just what they thought was proper to pray in church”.

If you have not had the privilege of reading this book I would recommend visiting your local Christian bookstore or finding the book on-line and picking up a copy. As the author states, I would also recommend not just reading or meditating on a Psalm, but to *PRAY* a Psalm today, and tomorrow, and the next day. Will you join me in Praying the Psalms as we continue to grow in our faith remembering some of what was emphasized during our Emmaus experience, Prayer, Study, Action and Discipleship?

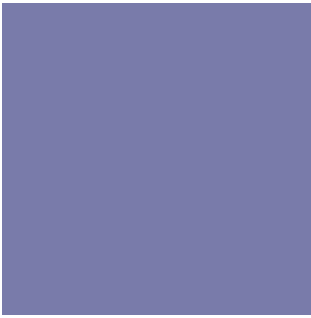
