On any given day, and even more recently, it seems many of these items are occurring on a daily basis both domestically and internationally and this does not even include all the Cyber related hacking and identity theft occurring daily.

Matthew 24:6 says, “And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet.” The rest of the passage seems very descriptive of both the past and the present. I would encourage you to read and reflect on Matthew 24:3-14.

As we see all these it may be easy to become discouraged or worried or fearful or confused. As the passage above says, see that you are not alarmed. As our main scripture reference says, we don't trust in things, we trust in the name of the Lord our God.

We were alerted earlier this week regarding the sinking of a cruise ship in China that sank during a cruise on the Yangtze River. We have actually taken a similar cruise there in the past. Let us reflect, just a moment, on the cares of this world that we see and experience every day. But more, let us be assured that we are placing our trust in the One who asks us to take our eyes off the natural and to fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith. (Heb 12:2)
