I sometimes say God can't speak to me in His "still small voice" because I never hear it. When He wants to get my attention He needs to speak to me with a 2x4 (whack). We often say and hear in Emmaus, there are no Co-Incidences, only God-Incidences. How exciting it is to see "Incidences" of God at work.

I saw a news article earlier this week regarding persecution in [China](#) where up to 1500 crosses had been removed (torn down) from churches and buildings. The Christians in the local area ended up strapping themselves to the remaining crosses to prevent them from being removed. It was stated the recent wave of persecution is the worst the country has seen since the 1970's. Yet in the face of difficult circumstances God's people respond in gentleness and humility.

I have a daily devotion I read on occasion called [Extreme Devotion](#). This is published by Voice of the Martyrs and details both ancient and modern examples of the persecuted church and what God's followers have and are willing to suffer in obedience to His work.

This week during an orientation for an upcoming mission trip I heard the person giving the orientation talk about their vision or the vision God has given them. This small group will travel to Atlanta, Georgia to minister on the streets of Atlanta but more importantly to be taught and to learn from the [Atlanta Dream Center](#). The ultimate goal of the trip is to bring a ministry to the Mid-Michigan area to directly confront and minister to the issue of human trafficking in this area.

Emmaus also has a vision, to equip Christian leaders through a short course in Christianity where participants (Pilgrims) will walk on a journey with our risen Lord.

How about you? Are you listening for and hearing God's voice (or do you need God to borrow my 2x4)? As you read, pray, study and meditate on His word, do you have a vision for ministry now or in the future? Is God planting His vision in you? Take a moment now to reflect on the vision of or for God in your life today.
