During the traditional school year there is a men's weekly bible study I attend. Several participants, myself included, have commented that they participate in this men's study program because if they did not, their spiritual discipline of bible reading and study would be less consistent. We have also all commented that over the summer, when the study is not in session, we are less consistent with our studies.

Last summer I went to the book store and bought several bible study books, two on Psalms and one on Proverbs. I didn't finish all three and was still less consistent than during the weekly men's study program but I could at least see and track progress. This year I never set up a program so I have been very inconsistent.

One area I have been consistent with is a daily morning devotion, there are two daily devotionals I try to read every day. While not perfect this year I have at least been consistent. More recently I have noted that for the remainder of the summer I need to step up and be consistent with my bible reading, not just my devotional and I need to be more consistent in dedicated prayer time.

My plan...

Mid-week our church offers a noon prayer time every week. I have not made this time a priority until the last two weeks so my plan to the extent my calendar allows is to take this weekly time of 45 minutes and attend this prayer time. As for bible study, it is time to dust off the Proverbs study and pick up where I left off last summer. Additionally, I have two commentary bibles which go into greater depth and detail about any specific passage. My intention is to utilize these two commentaries in part with the study as I read and reflect on the material.

Do I expect to be perfect? No. Will I beat myself up when I miss the mark? No. But, I hope this puts me back on track for the remainder of July and the month of August until our men's study group starts up again in September.

How are you doing with your spiritual discipline this summer? Take a moment to reflect on your current prayer, study and action...and if needed, make or update your current plan as necessary to finish the summer strong and continue through the rest of the year.
