Yet another God-incidence where circumstances were so arranged that last minute I was able to attend the recent [Global Leadership Summit](#) on August 6-7. I have heard about this program for several years but usually hear about it after the event. This year someone purchased tickets but ended up on a family vacation during the event. I was able to fill in and attend. Based out of Willow Creek the event was leadership driven and God focused. God was proclaimed and exalted by every speaker as they shared not only their success in leadership but also their research, their failure and their personal stories.

Some key take away messages I thought were worth sharing and I can often relate them to Emmaus and its goal to develop Christian Leaders to serve in their local church.

You can choose courage or comfort but not both – meaning if you step out in leadership to work and do and change it will often be difficult. To do what is comfortable may be easy but not always courageous. To do hard and difficult things may not be comfortable but can often effect change and if Godly focused can be impactful in sharing the Gospel message and advancing God's Kingdom.

It's ok to fail! In fact many famous and successful people have failed many times. But they didn't let it get them down and they didn't give up. They kept adjusting and kept trying over and over again. It's ok to fail, but not to give up.

Be others focused. We succeed most when our effort and focus is not on our self but on others. Teamwork is critical. Often we learned by someone taking time to lead, teach and mentor us and we often have opportunities to pay it forward by doing the same for others.

Music and worship often bring a peace and comfort in the middle of difficult times. God can often bring a song which may be appropriate for a circumstance or situation which you can play over and over and continue to hold on to and meditate on which will be just what you need.

Take a moment to reflect on these learning and see if or how they can be applied to your current situation or circumstance and your future leadership opportunities.
