On the Sunday of the Emmaus Weekend, Pilgrims are introduced to the 4th Day talk and the concept of 4th Day Reunion Groups. These are frequently referred to as Accountability Groups. Group dynamics play a key role in a successful 4th Day Group. Here are a few thoughts in no particular order and the list is certainly not complete. In fact, some may even disagree on certain points. The key then is to find out what works for you and your group and then make meeting a priority.

First, there must be commitment, if only one person shows up, it's difficult to have a meeting. The group should not be too large. If the group is too large some people will tend to remain silent or share less and with larger groups, it is difficult to finish in a specific period of time if you are meeting on a schedule before other events (breakfast, work, lunch, between activities). The group should be open to accepting new members, which may seem to contradict the previous thought about the group being too large. Successful reunion groups should welcome and encourage new members and even feel privileged if the group size grows such that it needs to break into smaller groups and then repeat the cycle, recruiting, growing and dividing increasing the total number of active groups. Confidentiality is critical to reunion groups. It may take time to build trust and for group members to share beyond surface level day to day thoughts. Getting deep into human and spiritual matters can be scary and nothing will divide a group faster than a breach in confidence of confidential or private sharing.

Many groups “follow the card” and truth be told, this is the best model to follow to stay focused on the task at hand, a focus on your walk with Christ since you last met. It is easy to divert and that is ok too as long as you remember the reason you are meeting and maintain a focus on your walk with Christ even if you don't “follow the card” every time.

If you are active in a 4th Day Group, great. We would love to hear from you and confirm if we have you listed in our database. If you don't mind, reply and share your group name, members and meeting day, time and location. Also let us know if you have availability to accept new members.

If you are not in a group but would like to be we would like to hear from you also. We will work to identify a group in your area and see if the meeting time would work with your schedule.

In short, take a moment to reflect on your walk. Are you trying to “go it alone” in your spiritual growth and development? Would you benefit from meeting with another Christian on a regular basis with whom you could both mentor and be mentored by?
