## Missions

WOW! I always look forward to October as it is Missions Month at our church. Here is how a typical October goes...Week 1, Church Missions Year in Review – a summary of giving and support where the church has had an impact in some way. Week 2, Focus on Domestic Missions – Guest speaker who speaks about U.S. Domestic Missions and the opportunities and needs facing all of us right here at home. Week 3, Guest speaker who speaks about International Missions and the global need for missions in our day. Week 4 (next week), will be a summary message and a call for mission pledge and support for the next 12 months, November through October annually.
