

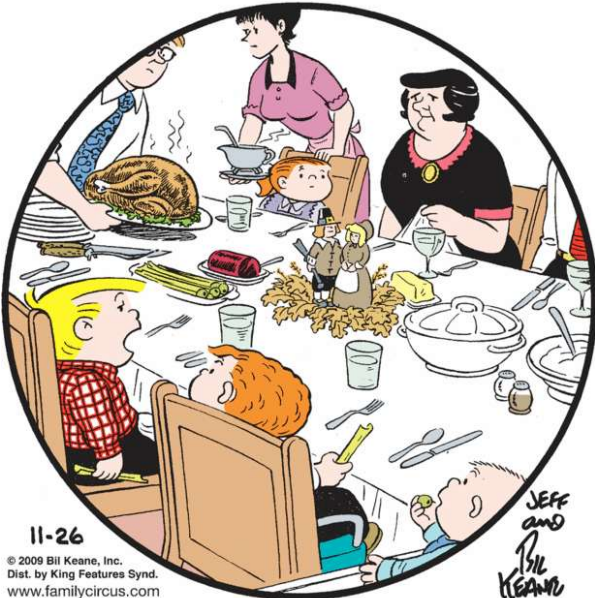

Welcome to our new Board Members, starting in 2025:

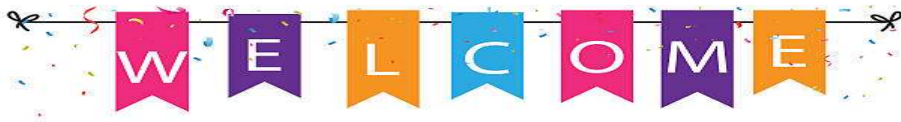

A Word on Sponsorship...

Reflecting on our recent journey through Election Season (thankfully), we were reminded of those who seemed to be somewhat “power hungry”. As we may sometimes feel we don’t have as much power as “they” do, we do have the power to change someone’s Christian journey.

“Just how do I do that?”, you may be asking... One way is to sponsor someone near and dear to you on our next set of [walks in the Spring of 2025](#). Just think of what Christ has done for you through the Emmaus movement...

Quality Sponsorship begins with prayer. Through prayer, God reveals to us who He may be wanting us to sponsor, to bring them closer to Him.

Quality Sponsorship fulfills the purpose of developing Christian leaders. Think about how you have grown since your Walk.

Quality Sponsorship provides an opportunity to broaden and grow His kingdom by sharing Christ’s love with the world. Isn’t that the number one commandment? To grow and make Disciples...
