

## Faithful Sponsorship: Guiding Pilgrims Toward the Walk to Emmaus...

Sponsorship on the Walk to Emmaus is not about recruiting—it's about serving. It is an act of love and discernment, entrusted with nurturing someone's spiritual journey, just as Christ walks alongside us on our own.

Webster defines a sponsor as one who presents a candidate for baptism or confirmation and "undertakes responsibility for the person's religious education or spiritual welfare." This responsibility lies at the heart of effective sponsorship on the Walk to Emmaus.

Sometimes, when we think of sponsoring a person on a Walk to Emmaus, the following thoughts may come to mind:

- The next Walk to Emmaus is just what "X" needs...
- The next Walk to Emmaus will fix "X", as they are broken...
- This will fix our marriage... I just need my husband/wife to go on a Walk...

While rooted in care and concern, these perspectives place the focus on *our* perceived solutions, not necessarily *God's timing and purpose*.

A faithful Sponsor should:

- 1. **Pray intentionally and consistently**—ask the Holy Spirit to place the right person on your heart.
- 2. **Discern with humility**—consider the prospective Pilgrim's life season, spiritual readiness, current responsibilities, and emotional openness.
- 3. **Consider the whole family**—pray for and understand the Pilgrim's household. What sacrifices might be required? How can you support them too?
- 4. **Submit to God's timing**—don't force an invitation. Be patient. If now isn't the right time, trust that God will reveal when it is.

Realize Sponsorship isn't a task—it's a sacred trust. When we invite someone to a Walk to Emmaus, we are stepping into a journey alongside them, both before and long after the weekend. Through prayer, discernment, and gentle guidance, we honor both the Pilgrim and the God who calls them.

### Seek His will above all. Let love lead.
